MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Craig Pinckney respectfully requests a **fourth and final** extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Craig Pinckney respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Corey William Brown with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2015. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Willie James Poole v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on August 17, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Michael Antonio Williams with the Court of Appeals on August 11, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Christopher Broadnax with the Supreme Court on August 6, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Wendall Wilkins with the Court of Appeals on August 5, 2015. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Rodney Alexander Nash v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 28, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Billy Alford with the Court of Appeals on July 23, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Steve Young with the Court of Appeals on July 23, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Shawn J. Burris with the Court of Appeals on July 16, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Charles Tramayne Myers with the Court of Appeals on July 13, 2015.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.






