Dear Counsel:

Since I am aware that there are a large number of attorneys and clients involved in this case, I wanted to remind counsel of the limited seating capacity in the Courtroom of the Supreme Court Building in Columbia, South Carolina. The first row of seating will be reserved for counsel in this case and the last row will be reserved for the staff of the Supreme Court. The remaining seats will be available until they are filled. Further, while these proceedings may be observed on a monitor in the lobby of the Supreme Court Building, seating to view this monitor is very limited.

As an alternative to attending the arguments at the Supreme Court Building, I wanted to make sure that you were aware that the arguments will be available for viewing by live-streaming while the arguments are taking place. Further, in addition to the live-streaming, a video of the arguments will be posted to the Judicial Department Website in a relative short period of time after the conclusion of the arguments. In light of the limited seating available at the Courtroom, I would ask that you make your clients and other interested persons aware of the limited seating, and of the availability of live-streaming and video as an alternative way to observe the arguments in this case.
