I have called the court every day since the 14th checking on the TRO; only to be told no action had been taken – each day I reminded Ms. Carter the emergency nature of the TRO. Yet, today I received an Order dismissing the appeal pursuant to Rule 203. I discovered the notice of appeal had not been filed while at the court on the 10th and filed said notice: my copy has the clerk's blue stamp. I informed Ms. Carter the circuit court did not issue an order: our motion to dismiss was issued from the bench.... Given the nature of the TRO – [i]t is properly before the Court and any additional matter may be addressed outside the TRO.... NOW, do we lose our HOME and \$3,000 because Ms. Carter made the decision to hold the TRO awaiting that which was filed and that which cannot be filed....
