Yesterday I spoke with Mr. Shearouse about my need to ask the Court to reschedule the oral argument in this case due to my father's upcoming surgery on Thursday of next week. We did not get notice if Dad's surgery

date until yesterday . I subsequently spoke with opposing counsel, Dave Spencer, and obtained his consent to my request that this oral argument be rescheduled for a later time. I wrote the Court a letter yesterday requesting that I be granted this consideration in light of this family medical crisis.

Earlier I called your office to check and be certain that my letter was hand-delivered to the Court yesterday. It occurred to me, unfortunately after the fact, that my staff might have just mailed it rather than having it delivered by my assistant.
