ORDER

Appellant has filed a petition for supersedeas seeking to stay the master's order of foreclosure and sale. This court temporarily granted the stay of the sale pending this court's receipt and review of a return to the petition for supersedeas. After review of the parties' filings, it appears to this court that although a proposed order on the motion for an appeal bond and stay of sale has been submitted to the master, no written order has yet been filed. Accordingly, this appeal will be held in abeyance for the master to file its written order on the motion for an appeal bond and stay of the sale. This court's temporary stay shall remain in effect only until the master files its order. The master is urged to act as expeditiously as possible. Counsel for Appellant shall provide this court with a status update in thirty days.
