
Motion for Second Extension to File Appellant Jacobs' Initial Brief

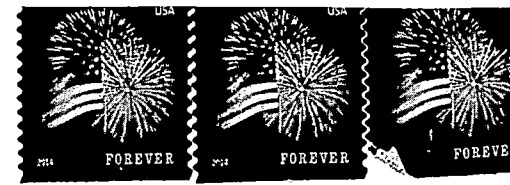
