Probation Violation as ordered by Judge Doyet Early at November 14, 2011 term of General Sessions Court, Aiken, SC.

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

Annie Victoria Wilson has failed to report as instructed. She was instructed to report back to the probation office on June 17, 2015 after she was just released from the ACDC on 6/12/15. Efforts were in place to get her into inpatient treatment but to no avail as she has never reported back to the probation office. She has disregarded this office in every way. Subject has failed to refrain from any further local charges/convictions in that she was arrested and convicted of DUS, receiving a sentence of 30 days in Magistrate Court, after a Bench Warrant had been issued for her arrest; Subject has failed to pay her Court Fine as ordered in that she is \$506.00 in arrears, having paid -0-, Subject has failed to pay DACOR in that she is 2,905 in arrears, having paid a total of \$1,187.00, she has only paid \$155.00 in the year 2015, Subject has failed to enroll in drug treatment after the Supervising Supervisor, Charles Finch has tried to no avail to get her into treatment and by failing to follow the advice and instructions of her agent, which constitutes a violation of Sections 1, 6,
