ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to transport and unseal Exhibit 2, records from the Department of Social Services pertaining to the family of the two minor victims. The State does not oppose the motion to transport but asserts the exhibit should be sealed by this court.

We find the parties are entitled to have access to the records while they prepare for the appeal. However, it is not necessary to transport the exhibit to this court at this time.
