
**Motion for Extension of Time to Serve Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal**



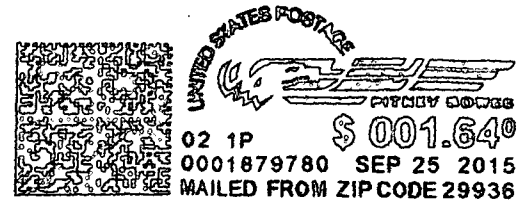
