This letter is regarding an appeal to indictment #s ~~JUN 15 2015~~ 2015-GS-32-767, 2007-GS-32-3211, and 2007-GS-32-3212 filed by Eleventh Circuit Assistant Public Defender Thomas E. Shealy on April 16, 2015. SC Court of Appeals

My name is Brian J. Terrell, Defendant on Above Indictments. I do not know who is representing me in the court of appeals and would like to find out, so that I may address this person directly. As such, I hope this letter reaches that person. Below I have written a detailed explanation of why I believe I have been given an illegal sentence and how it should be rectified. These issues bear looking into.

On January 31, 2008 I pled guilty to Indictments 2007-GS-32-3211, 2007-GS-32-3212, 2007-GS-32-3213, 2007-GS-32-3214, 2007-GS-32-3492, 2007-GS-32-3493, and 2007-GS-32-3494. I received a sentence of 12 years in the Department of Corrections concurrent on Indictment #s -3213, -3214, -3492, -3493, and -3494. On # -3211 I received a sentence of 5 years suspended to 5 years probation "Toll probation while in Jail" (sic) and was consecutive to # -3212 and concurrent with -3213, -3214, -3492, -3493, and -3494. On # -3212 I received a sentence of 10 years suspended to 5 years probation "Toll probation while in Jail" (sic) and was consecutive to # -3211 and concurrent to -3213, -3214, -3492, -3493, and -3494.

On April 15, 2015 I pled Guilty to Indictment # 2015-GS-32-767 which violated the probation inflicted in 2007-GS-32-3211 and 2007-GS-32-3212. I received a 3 year sentence to run consecutive with Both Probation Revocations. 5 years and 10 year respectively. resulting in a total commitment of 18 years.

As Indictments 2007-GS-32-3211 and 2007-GS-32-3212 were consecutive to each other but concurrent to -3213, -3214, -3492, -3493, and -3494 the total exposure should have been only 6 years. 3 for # 2015-GS-32-767 and 3 for # -3211, and -3212 (15 total minus 12 served on concurrent sentences)

or an alternate possibility which bears even more investigation is: a total exposure of 3 years. 3 from # 2015-GS-32-767 and Q from # -3211, and -3212 (Both # -3211 and # -3212 were run concurrent with #s -3213, -3214, -3492, -3493, and -3494 and the Active time was more than 5 years (# -3211) and more than 10 years (# -3212))


In either case I was given a sentence that was without the 12 years credit that was served under concurrent sentences.

The relevant Sentencing Sheets and Indictments were preserved as a court's exhibit in Indictment # 2015-GS-32-767.
