



**MOTION PURSUANT TO  
RULE 60(b)**

On May 25, 2015, the Applicant was served with a Final Order of Dismissal in the above referenced case. This Order of Dismissal addressed a number of issues raised before the Court. In addition it states that the Applicant complained of collateral consequences which is not cognizable under the Post-Conviction Relief Act, but fails to specifically state that the Applicant complains that he received improper advice from Trial Counsel on his 1992 Armed Robbery and Murder charges. He was not advised by counsel that upon his conviction, he would be ineligible for parole and would be facing a Life without Parole sentence. Had he been properly advised by counsel he would have accepted an earlier plea offer. This issue was specifically set out in the Applicant's original filings and Return to the Court's Conditional Order of Dismissal.

That the Applicant would respectfully request that the Order be corrected to clarify this issue.
