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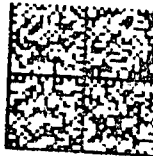

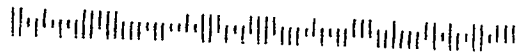

Affidavit In Support Of Motion For Extension Of Time To Appeal

Derrick L. Cheeks, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

That I am the defendant herein and submit this affidavit in support of my application for leave to serve a notice of appeal within thirty days after the granting of an order permitting me to file a motion for extension of time of civil procedure law of the State of South Carolina.

On December 13, 2013, an order was entered for the forfeiture of funds by the Hon Berham Cole.

I failed to file a Notice of Appeal within thirty days because:

Though no fault of appellants own, On December 13, 2013, the appellant was summoned to court by Spartanburg County without any type of notice from Lea Carr Inst to appear in civil court for the forfeiture of funds. Appellant didnt find out what he was being transferred to Spartanburg County for until he got there. The case was dismissed on the 13th day of December 2013, and judge stated that he would send appellant the decision. The appellant then asked the court for a continuance so that he could show the court's that the case was in fact dismiss and that the funds involved in this civil proceeding should be returned to him. The appellant stated to Judge that his charge had already been dismissed, and (See) Exhibit A. But for some reason the courts proceeded with hearing and entered an order for the forfeiture of funds. Then mailed the imposed order to the South Carolina Department of Correction P.O Box Address. Which is not the appellants inmate number or address (see Exhibit B) and mailed it without appellants inmate number, so that appellant could receive the order in time to file the necessary appeal with the thirty day time limit, and appellant would further state that upon receiving said order on January 8, 2013, the appellants institution was on lockdown and the entire institution was quarantined for two weeks making it hard for appellant to even file a timely notice of appeal. After institution came off lockdown because of Flu Epidemic, the institution came back on lockdown because of the snow and ice. Last after institution gang riot and the dorm appellant reside in had a riot. The appellant havent been to the law library in over 2 months but if the order would have sent the order to appellants institution he would have had plenty of time to appeal the order prior to the lockdown situation that occurred.

Wherefore, I respectfully pray this court extend the time within which a notice of appeal may be served and filed appellant should not be held responsible for failure to file because this was done on purpose so appellant couldnt appeal Judge's decision in a timely manner the judge and solicitor didnt send for the P.O Box Address when I was transferred to Spartanburg County because if they would have I wouldnt have been present for my hearing

Would you please explain to me why do I have to pay a filing fee as an indigent appellant. Ms Jenny Abbott Kitchings forwarded me two letters one on January 26, 2015 and one on February 13, 2015. Curiously she didnt assert anything about the filing fee being a deficiency in the January 26, 2015 letter. In addition she asserts in the February 13, 2015 that I only have a ten day deadline to pay the filing fee or my appeal

will be dismissed. Mr Shearouse you are very cognizant ¹⁰ of the fact that I have been trying to file this appeal since the beginning of 2014 but ms Jenny Abbott Kitchings wait a whole year later to inform me of a filing fee deadline, as if I'm out in society getting paid for my work hours. To put a filing fee burden on me as an indigent appellant would be a violation of my equal protection rights of the United States Constitution 5,14 and South Carolina Constitution Article 1~~5~~ 3. I'm similarly situated to each and every individual incarcerated in the Department of Corrections that's appealing a plethora of judicial orders. In closing I have yet to see a ruling by the United States or South Carolina Supreme Court asserting that all indigent appellants have to pay their filing fees. 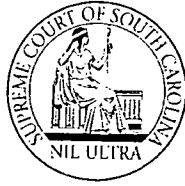

On December ¹³ 14, 2014, a forfeiture hearing was held in front of the Honorable Derham Cole in the court of common pleas in Spartanburg County. I received the order signed by the Judge on January 8, 2014, due to the fact the order was mailed to a P.O. Box in Columbia, SC, instead of the institution, and without my inmate number on it. (See Attachment Envelope Dated January 8, 2014). At the time I received the order the institution was on lockdown due to the flu epidemic and snow storm. Without any access to the Law Library I did the best I could in writing up a Notice of Appeal and a Motion for Extension of Time. I mailed a copy to the clerk M. Hope Blackley of Spartanburg County and the Clerk Tonya A. Gee's P.O. Box. Spartanburg County clerk responded that I had to file my own Appeal. (See Attachment Letter Dated February 21, 2014). I never received a response from Tonya Gee, so I wrote the Honorable Daniel E. Shearouse inquiring about my Appeal. (See Attachment Letter Dated November 24, 2014). He responded that he searched the records and didn't find where any appeal had been filed. (See Attachment Letter Dated December 1, 2014). I responded back to him asserting did

he check ms. Gee's P.O. Box and enclosed a copy of the Notice of Appeal mailed to Spartanburg County. (See Attachment Letter Dated December 9, 2014). Curiously on January 26, 2015, I received a letter from the Honorable Jenny Abbott Kitchings, asserting an Appellant Case No: 2014-002647 asserting that I had to correct some deficiencies, mailed a copy to M. Hope Blackley and Jenny Abbott Kitchings. (See Attachments Letters, Notice of Appeal, Copy of

Order, and Proof of Service dated February 3, 2015). On February 13, 2015, Jenny Abbott Kitchings responded the court received my Notice of Appeal, the case had been assigned another case No: 2015-00238, and asserted the only deficiency I had to correct was a \$100.00 filing fee. (See Attachment Letters Dated February 13, 2015). I wrote Daniel E. Shearouse, inquiring why I had to pay a \$100.00 filing fee as an indigent Appellant but received no response. (See Attachment Letter Dated February 19, 2015). Curiously, on February 27, 2015, Jenny Abbott Kitchings, mailed another letter in equipoise to the January 26, 2015, letter asserting that I had to correct the same deficiencies I had just corrected on February 3, 2015. (See Attachment Letter Dated February 27, 2015). I wrote to Chief Justice Jean Toal asserting that the Court of Appeal clerks refuse to file my Appeal. (See Attachment Letter Dated March 10, 2015). On March 12, 2015, Daniel E. Shearouse responded the Chief Justice cannot consider Exparte Communication. (See Attachment Letter Dated March 12, 2015). Curiously, on April 6, 2015, I received an order from the Court of Appeal asserting that I failed to comply with the letters dated January 26, 2015, and February 27, 2015, and as a result my appeal was dismissed. (See Attachment Letter Order of Dismissal). The record unequivocally reveal the January 26, and February 27, 2015 letters are in equipoise in reference to the deficiencies I had to correct, I corrected the deficiencies on February 3, 2015, as a result the Court of Appeals responded my appeal was received, filed, and the only deficiency I had to correct was \$100.00 filing fee. Petitioner seeks a writ of mandamus to compel the Clerk of the South Carolina Court of Appeals to file his notice of appeal.

The Court of Appeals has filed two notices of appeal in this matter.¹ This renders moot the only relief that has been requested in the petition for a writ of mandamus.

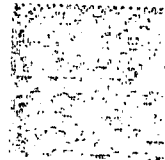

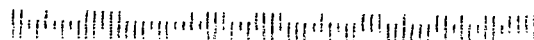

That I am the defendant herein and submit this affidavit in support of my application for leave to serve a notice of appeal within thirty days after the granting of an order permitting me to file a motion for extension of time of civil procedure law of the State of South Carolina.

On December 13, 2013, an order was entered for the forfeiture of funds by the Hon Berham Cole.

I failed to file a notice of appeal within thirty days because,

Though no fault of appellants own, On December 13, 2013, the appellant was summoned to court by Spartanburg County without any type of notice from Lee Carr Inst to appear in civil court for the forfeiture of funds. 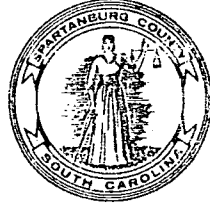

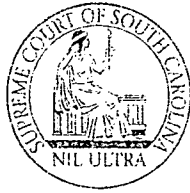

I received the order signed by the Judge on January 8, 2014, due to the fact the order was mailed to a P.O. Box in Columbia, SC, instead of the institution, and without my inmate number on it. (See Attachment Envelope Dated January 8, 2014). At the time I received the order the institution was on lockdown due to the flu epidemic and snow storm. Without any access to the Law Library I did the best I could in writing up a Notice of Appeal and a Motion for Extension of Time. I mailed a copy to the clerk M. Hope Blackley of Spartanburg County and the Clerk Tonya A. Gee's P.O. Box. Spartanburg County clerk responded that I had to file my own Appeal. (See Attachment Letter Dated February 21, 2014). I never received a response from Tonya Gee, so I wrote the Honorable Daniel E. Shearouse inquiring about my Appeal. (See Attachment Letter Dated November 24, 2014). He responded that he searched the records and didn't find where any appeal had been filed. (See Attachment Letter Dated December 1, 2014). I responded back to him asserting did

he check ms. Gee s P.O. Box and enclosed a copy of the Notice of Appeal mailed to Spartanburg County. (See Attachment Letter Dated December 9, 2014). Curiously on January 26, 2015, I

received a letter from the Honorable Jenny Abbott Kitchings, asserting an Appellant Case No:

2014-002647 asserting that I had to correct some deficiencies, mailed a copy to M. Hope

Petitioner seeks a writ of mandamus to compel the Clerk of the South Carolina Court of Appeals to file his notice of appeal.

The Court of Appeals has filed two notices of appeal in this matter.¹ This renders moot the only relief that has been requested in the petition for a writ of mandamus.

Further, to the extent that petitioner may be asking this Court to review the actions taken by the Clerk of the Court of Appeals once the notices of appeal were filed, we decline to do so.
