In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following exigent circumstances:



State in the Supreme Court on August 26, 2015. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of John Forest Ham, Jr. v. State in the Supreme Court on August 20, 2015. Counsel filed the final brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Timmy Eugene Rice in the court of Appeals on August 20, 2015. Counsel filed Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Austen McKeever in the Court of Appeals on August 5, 2015.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel is striving to limit the number of extensions requested. Counsel is attempting to complete the cases with the most number of extensions first.


4. As indicated by consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.
