4. I have attempted to comply as best as I can with all other corrections. (see notice of appeal and previous service)

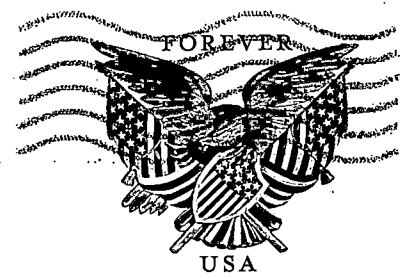
5. If I get a response from Lexington County, I will send the order and correct the judge's name.

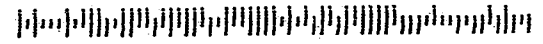
