SUPPLEMENT RECORD


The Appellant, proceeding pro-se in this matter, humbly request permission to add to the Record corresponding court filed documents that are pertinent to this appeal.


This matter comes before the Court upon a Request for Extension pursuant to S.C. Code §44-48-80(D) (as amended May 12, 2010).


This is a pending sexually violent predator case, and Dr. Marie E. Gehle of the South Carolina Department of Mental Health was ordered by this Court to evaluate Respondent pursuant to the Sexually Violent Predator Act, by Order filed October 1, 2012.

The qualifying convictions involve Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, and in order to complete her report Dr. Gehle has asked if there exist descriptions of the images on which these convictions were based, or copies of the actual images. S.C. Code Ann. Section 16-15-410 prohibits possession of material that contains a visual representation of a minor in sexual activity. An exception is found at Section 16-15-410 (D), regarding the South Carolina Attorney General's Office and other law enforcement agencies. The case file containing images relevant to this matter are, according to counsel for the State, in the possession of Richland County Sheriff's Department Investigator Reggie Gaymon.

Given the nature of the convictions for Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, and that law enforcement has in its possession a file containing the images in question, Dr. Gehle and Respondent's attorney may, as part of the evaluation ordered herein and in furtherance of representation of Respondent, schedule an appointment with the Attorney General's Office or Investigator Gaymon to view these photographs.


This matter came before me on Motion from the Respondent, by and through his undersigned attorney, requesting that the services of a Forensic Psychiatrist (Thomas V. Martin, M.D.) be provided to perform a Psychiatric Evaluation of the Respondent that would specifically test the Respondents' propensity to commit sexually violent crimes. The Respondent has already been determined to be indigent. The Respondent further requests that the expenditure be approved to compensate the expert at an estimated rate of Six Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$6,100.00 (\$2,500 for evaluation and \$3,600 for court appearance if required)) for the performance of the evaluation and Court Testimony if needed. The basis for this Order is that the Court has required that the Respondent submit to an evaluation in this matter and the State has utilized the services of a forensic psychiatrist. As such, the Respondent is in need of his own similarly qualified expert in order to the address the contentions of the State of South Carolina. This motion is made pursuant to 44-48-90 Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina 1976, as amended.

**IT IS SO ORDERED:**

That this Court authorizes the payment of approximately Five Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$5,500.00) for Respondent to be evaluated by a forensic psychiatrist.
