Dear Mr. Shearouse:

By letter dated Monday October 12, 2015 sent by regular mail which was received by my office on Friday, October 16th, the Court notified the parties that the Court had granted the Motion to exceed the page limit and notified me that I had 10 days from the date of the Order to file a reply. I do not know why this took 5 days to get to me, but would assume this in part was probably due to the flood situation and the shutdown of Federal and State offices that week after. In any event, because of the flooding, everything that would have been normally received the week before, particularly from State agencies all came out this past week. I am sure you can understand the tremendous amount of additional work load that has come about throughout the system. (Please note: I am mindful of the Court's caution in its Order concerning extensions and workloads and make these comments only in reference to the unusual situation caused by the flood.)

As a result of us receiving this in the mail Friday afternoon, I in fact had 3 days to file a reply and I would request a 10 day extension for the filing of my reply in this matter. The \$25.00 filing fee, which I assume applies, is enclosed.

Because of the extra-ordinary situation caused by the flood and pursuant to the Supreme Court Order filed as 2014-07-16-01, I would request the Court's consideration of not applying this 10 day extension to the total 20 day extension




