MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE  
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Counsel respectfully requests a thirty day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. On October 26, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Stepheno Jermaine Alston with this Court. On October 22, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Montez Barker v. State with this Court. On October 14, 2015, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Ricky L. Hayes with the Court of Appeals. On October 13, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Keith Desue v. State with this Court. On October 12, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Harold Watts v. State with this Court. On October 2, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Levon D. Black v. State with this Court. On October 1, 2015, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Carnail Marchindla Graham with the Court of Appeals. On September 21-23, 2015, counsel attended the Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. On September 18, 2015, counsel filed a petition for rehearing in State v. Tiphani Marie Parkhurst with the Court of Appeals. On September 15, 2015, counsel held an oral argument in State v. Don Survi Chisolm before the Court of Appeals. On September 8, 2015, counsel held an oral argument in State v. Frankie Lee Bryant before the Court of Appeals. On August 25, 2015, counsel filed the brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. David Dover with the Court of Appeals. On August 19, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter In the matter of the care and treatment of Carl M. Asquith with the Court of Appeals.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload

will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


