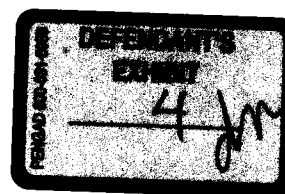

14 BROOKE PARKER: Good. Well, I have to talk at
15 the trial.

16 BRETT PARKER: Huh?

17 BROOKE PARKER: I have to talk at the trial.

18 BRETT PARKER: You have to talk to Kyle
19 (PHONETIC)?

20 BROOKE PARKER: No, I have to talk at the trial.

21 BRETT PARKER: Oh, okay. Yeah, that's what I
22 heard. But that's -- yeah, we won't talk about that
23 over the phone, but that's -- well, you know -- well,
24 it's good, though. I mean, you know, 'cause they're
25 trying to lie about stuff, you know what I mean?

1 BROOKE PARKER: well, I have a question. How
2 did he carry it out?

3 BRETT PARKER: Huh?

4 BROOKE PARKER: How did he carry the gun out?

5 BRETT PARKER: How did he?

6 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah, like, it was in --

7 BRETT PARKER: In his --

8 BROOKE PARKER: -- his pocket or, like --

9 BRETT PARKER: -- in his bag.

10 BROOKE PARKER: what bag?

11 BRETT PARKER: He put it in his bag, in that
12 tote bag he always brings over there.

13 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah, well, 'cause they asked me
14 that, and I didn't know. I could remember it
15 correctly.

16 BRETT PARKER: Yeah. I mean, he put it in the
17 bag, whatever he brought. He brought a bag every
18 time he came over to the house.

19 BROOKE PARKER: well, should I tell them that?

20 BRETT PARKER: I -- no -- just whatever. I
21 don't know. (INDISTINCT COMMENT)

22 BROOKE PARKER: well, I mean, I'll just tell
23 them that and just tell them I saw that.

24 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, well, whatever. I don't
25 know, Brooke. Just, just don't -- we don't need to

1 talk about that now. Just talk to them, but that's
2 what, you know -- that's where he -- he put it in the
3 bag, where he always brought it. He brought it over
4 there. You know, he always brought a bag over there,
5 so. I mean, it's ridiculous that they're just trying
6 to lie about everything, but, you know.

7 BROOKE PARKER: Well --

2 BRETT PARKER: Well, maybe next year, you can,
3 if you don't want to do the varsity cheerleading,
4 just run track or something and just cheer at ACX.

5 BROOKE PARKER: Well, I can't do ACX and varsity
6 track.

7 BRETT PARKER: Oh, yeah, that's right.

8 BROOKE PARKER: I can only do --

9 BRETT PARKER: That's right. That interferes
10 with it, so. Yeah, that interferes with it, so.
11 Anyway. Well, let me speak to Granny 'cause I'm
12 going to run out of time. How -- is school going
13 good for you?

14 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah.

15 BRETT PARKER: You like high school?

16 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah.

17 BRETT PARKER: Okay, well, good, good. Good,
18 good. You all practice every day after school, don't
19 you?

20 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah, except Fridays.

21 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, except Fridays, okay. All
22 right, well, what you doing for your birthday this
23 weekend? Have you all decided?

24 BROOKE PARKER: No. I think we're probably
25 having people over next weekend.

1 BRETT PARKER: Oh, not this weekend, but next?

2 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah, 'cause it's too soon.

3 BRETT PARKER: Oh, okay. Okay. All right,
4 well, let me say something to Granny, and then I'll
5 try to call you again this weekend or something
6 'cause I know you've got practice tomorrow night,
7 right?

8 BROOKE PARKER: Yeah.

9 BRETT PARKER: Okay, well, take care and have a
10 good birthday. I hate I miss it, but at least I got
11 to send you a card and you got your phone, so.

12 BROOKE PARKER: I did.

13 BRETT PARKER: You got a bunch of games loaded
14 on it?

15 BROOKE PARKER: No, I don't really play games
16 that much.

17 BRETT PARKER: Oh, okay, okay. All right, well,
18 have a --

19 BROOKE PARKER: Okay.

20 BRETT PARKER: I'll talk to you later. I love
21 you.

22 BROOKE PARKER: Love you too.

23 BRETT PARKER: Okay.

24 BROOKE PARKER: Bye.

25 BRETT PARKER: Bye.

1 LINDA PARKER: Hey.

2 BRETT PARKER: Hey.

3 LINDA PARKER: Here, here, Brooke. Here's your
4 pants (INDISTINCT COMMENT).

5 BRETT PARKER: Yeah. All right.

6 LINDA PARKER: Oh, gosh.

7 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, she's trying to talk to me
8 about all that stuff. She don't need to worry, you
9 know.

10 LINDA PARKER: Yes, she doesn't. Yeah, she just
11 wants to do what's right.

12 BRETT PARKER: I know. I know. I know.

13 LINDA PARKER: She's good, though. She's good
14 with it.

15 BRETT PARKER: I -- huh?

16 LINDA PARKER: She's good with it. I mean, you
17 know.

18 BRETT PARKER: Well, she knows -- I mean, she
19 knows we've got it, you know.

20 LINDA PARKER: Yeah, I know.

21 BRETT PARKER: That, that, that's --

22 LINDA PARKER: She does.

23 BRETT PARKER: -- that's the main thing. I
24 ain't wor -- you know --

25 LINDA PARKER: That's it.

1 BRETT PARKER: I'm sick of these people lying
2 all the time. I'm just sick of it.

3 LINDA PARKER: I know it.

4 BRETT PARKER: You know, but I, like I told Dad,
5 I can't sit up here and read through that stuff every
6 day. It drives me crazy.

7 LINDA PARKER: No. No, you --

8 BRETT PARKER: I've got to -- I've, I've wrote
9 down what I need to write. If they need more --

10 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

11 BRETT PARKER: -- when they come back, then I'll
12 do more.

13 LINDA PARKER: Right.

14 BRETT PARKER: I can't sit up here and worry
15 about it 'cause I don't sleep at night worrying about
16 --

17 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

18 BRETT PARKER: -- all this stuff, and I can't do
19 it.

20 LINDA PARKER: Well, no. No, you don't need --

21 BRETT PARKER: And I've just got to sit up here
22 and make the best of it and just --

23 LINDA PARKER: That's it. That's all you can
24 do.

25 BRETT PARKER: -- you know, that's all I can do.

1 LINDA PARKER: I --

2 BRETT PARKER: I got the Bible today.

3 LINDA PARKER: Did you? Okay, good.

4 BRETT PARKER: And it was -- it had my name on
5 it, and there's about three or four other people that
6 are downstairs that saw it, and they said, Man,
7 where'd you get that? That is nice. And --

8 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

9 BRETT PARKER: -- even one of the officers asked
10 me -- wanted to know where you got it, and I told him
11 the Christian store on (INDISTINCT COMMENT).

12 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

13 BRETT PARKER: He said, Oh, okay --

14 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

15 BRETT PARKER: -- well, I know where it is. The
16 guy that was in here with us all day, the officer?

17 LINDA PARKER: Mm-hmm.

18 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, he, he's cool. Well, all
19 of them are. I mean, you know, I don't ha -- we
20 don't have no problems with them. They --

21 LINDA PARKER: Is there anybody there that wants
22 a Bible that doesn't have one or anything that you
23 know of, or?

24 BRETT PARKER: You know, I'd have to check. I,
25 I don't know if they've got them here or --

1 LINDA PARKER: Yeah. Well, they, they asked --
2 the girl said, Do you want to put his name on it?
3 And I said yeah. It was, like, I don't know, four or
4 five dollars, and --

5 BRETT PARKER: Right.

6 LINDA PARKER: -- said we just (INDISTINCT
7 COMMENT) it. All we've got to do is (INDISTINCT
8 COMMENT) it. It doesn't take any extra time.

9 BRETT PARKER: Right.

10 LINDA PARKER: I said, Yeah, put his name on it.

11 BRETT PARKER: I'll see if somebody -- why, are
12 you all going to get another one or?

13 LINDA PARKER: Well, I just thought if there was
14 somebody that didn't have anybody to send them one, I
15 --

16 BRETT PARKER: How much are they?

17 LINDA PARKER: That one was about \$30, I think.

18 BRETT PARKER: Really? I'd like to get -- I
19 wish I could get these two guys up here -- they
20 helped me out so much the first couple weeks, and
21 they --

22 LINDA PARKER: Well --

23 BRETT PARKER: -- loved it too.

24 LINDA PARKER: They what?

25 BRETT PARKER: They loved it.

1 LINDA PARKER: Loved what?

2 BRETT PARKER: The, the Bible.

3 LINDA PARKER: Well, if you get their numbers, I
4 mean, I'll send them one.

5 BRETT PARKER: All right.

6 LINDA PARKER: And you have to get me their
7 names, though.

8 BRETT PARKER: Well, put -- I want you to put
9 their, their nicknames on it.

10 LINDA PARKER: Okay.

11 BRETT PARKER: Would you do Lolo --

12 LINDA PARKER: Wait a minute. Hold on a minute.
13 Let's see -- ooh, oh. Brett?

14 BRETT PARKER: Yeah.

15 LINDA PARKER: Okay, what is it now?

16 BRETT PARKER: Lolo.

17 LINDA PARKER: L-O-L-O?

18 BRETT PARKER: Mm-hmm. And then, and then Till,
19 T-I-L-L.

20 LINDA PARKER: T-I-L-L.

21 BRETT PARKER: Right.

22 LINDA PARKER: L-O-L-O and then Till, T-I-L-L,
23 okay.

24 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, but they're going to have
25 to --

1 LINDA PARKER: I've got to have their numbers,
2 though.

3 BRETT PARKER: Yeah. Shoot.

4 LINDA PARKER: Well, maybe --

5 BRETT PARKER: Let me get it from them, and then
6 I'll have to give it to you tomorrow. How about
7 that?

8 LINDA PARKER: That, that'll be good.

9 BRETT PARKER: Okay.

10 LINDA PARKER: That'll be good.

11 BRETT PARKER: All right.

12 LINDA PARKER: And you can just give me the
13 names and everything tomorrow?

14 BRETT PARKER: I will, and then you can put
15 their whole -- yeah, I'll just do that 'cause I -- by
16 the time I get it now, our phone will be off. It'll
17 be, you know --

18 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

19 BRETT PARKER: -- we'll run out of minutes, so.

20 LINDA PARKER: Well, I checked on the --

21 BRETT PARKER: I'll get it from them.

22 LINDA PARKER: -- I checked on the magazines,
23 but they said on new subscriptions --

24 BRETT PARKER: Uh-huh.

25 LINDA PARKER: -- it takes anywhere -- it can

1 take four to eight weeks before --

2 BRETT PARKER: Oh, okay.

3 LINDA PARKER: -- they start.

4 BRETT PARKER: And the paper didn't come. Maybe
5 it'll be tomorrow.

6 LINDA PARKER: Well, I, I, I e-mailed them today
7 because I never got a confirmation on that because I
8 did it -- you know, they told me --

9 BRETT PARKER: Oh, okay.

10 LINDA PARKER: -- to go online and do it.

11 BRETT PARKER: Uh-huh.

12 LINDA PARKER: But it took my credit card and
13 everything, so it had if you're -- if you have a
14 question about a recent subscription, so I sent them
15 an e-mail today. I hope I hear from that in the
16 morning.

17 BRETT PARKER: Okay, good.

18 LINDA PARKER: But, but I'm glad you got that
19 Bible. That's good to know. I mean, if there's any
20 --

21 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, I got it.

22 LINDA PARKER: And you can get books like that
23 too.

24 BRETT PARKER: Yeah, yeah.

25 LINDA PARKER: Well, I mean, if you knew of any

1 books --

2 BRETT PARKER: I've got to -- yes, I do, and
3 I'll give you those names tomorrow night. We read a
4 book. You know, we passed it around.

5 LINDA PARKER: Mm-hmm.

6 BRETT PARKER: And it's a series.

7 LINDA PARKER: Mm-hmm.

8 BRETT PARKER: But you can't get it in the
9 library.

10 LINDA PARKER: All right.

11 BRETT PARKER: So I would like to get it.

12 LINDA PARKER: Okay.

13 BRETT PARKER: And Sandra (PHONETIC) had
14 mentioned something about wanting to get a book or
15 two.

16 LINDA PARKER: Yeah.

17 BRETT PARKER: And I can give you the names of
18 them tomorrow.

19 LINDA PARKER: Well, just, just give me the
20 names of them --

21 BRETT PARKER: I will.

22 LINDA PARKER: -- and if you can get me, like,
23 their names --

24 BRETT PARKER: I will.

25 LINDA PARKER: -- and their numbers. I have to

1 have their numbers --

2 BRETT PARKER: I know, yeah.

3 LINDA PARKER: -- in order to send them that.

4 BRETT PARKER: Okay. I'll do it.

5 LINDA PARKER: Okay.

6 BRETT PARKER: Okay.

7 LINDA PARKER: All right.

8 BRETT PARKER: Well, I'll let you all go, and
9 I'll call you tomorrow night. I'm glad I got --

10 LINDA PARKER: All right.

11 BRETT PARKER: -- to talk to Brooke and Zack. I

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
