
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SERVE AND FILE INITIAL BRIEF OF

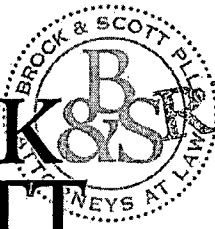

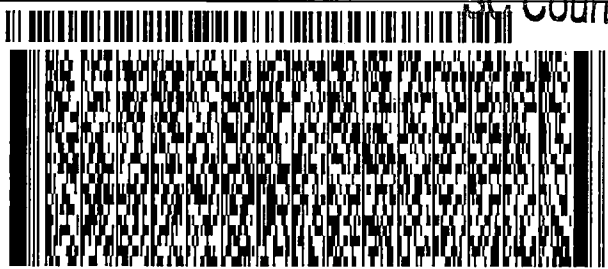

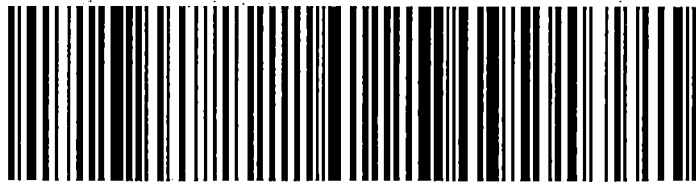
