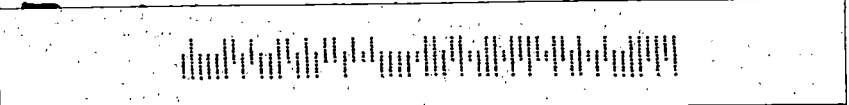
To the Clerk of Court,

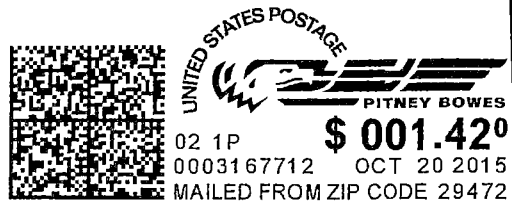
