

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the pages have not been numbered.
- According to Rule 208(b)(1)(A), (B), (C), (D), and (E), SCACR the Appellant's initial brief shall contain a statement of issues on appeal, a table of contents and cases, a statement of the case, an argument, and a conclusion. The document you filed does not have these items. While your filing does indicate there is an argument and conclusion, they are not accurately formatted.
- Rule 208(b)(4) states that the brief shall also contain references to the transcript, pleadings, orders, exhibits, or other materials which may be included in the record on appeal. Your brief includes no references to any material.
