**MOTION TO FILE AMENDED

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, undersigned counsel moves to file an amended Anders brief of appellant. In support of this request, counsel shows:

(1) The Anders brief of appellant was served and filed with this Court on October 28, 2015. The brief filed with this Court, served on the state, and served on appellant included a “sticky note” with an editing note on page six. (4) Counsel has informed Donald Zelenka, Esquire of the errors via email today. Mr. Zelenka consents to counsel's request to file an amended Anders brief of appellant as shown by his signature below.


WHEREFORE, counsel for Appellant respectfully requests the Court accept the amended Anders brief of appellant as filed.




