**Motion for an Extension of Time to File Petition for a Writ of Certiorari**

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Petitioner Leslie Todd Parvin ("Parvin") moves this Court for an extension of time to file his petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned matter. Parvin requests a seven (7) day extension of time from November 9, 2015, until November 16, 2015, to file his writ of certiorari. Parvin will not request any further extension of this deadline.

The extension is needed because undersigned counsel for Parvin had numerous other conflicting deadlines, work obligations, including oral argument before the Court of Appeals, and trial level hearings that precludes undersigned counsel from completing the petition for a writ of certiorari within the current deadline. Moreover, counsel was out of the office for business travel for several days during the current deadline.

Therefore, for good cause shown, Appellant moves this Court to extend the deadline for his petition for a writ of certiorari until November 16, 2015. Appellant asks that the current deadline be held in abeyance pending the Court's resolution of this motion. This request is exempt from filing fees per Rule 240(d), SCACR.
