After consideration of the submissions and agreements of the parties, the Plaintiff's Motion to Alter or Amend my Final Order filed September 21, 2015, is granted in part as follows:


1. Paragraph four (4) which begins on Page six (6) of my Conclusions of Law is amended by adding the following words "in the State of South Carolina" to the end of the last sentence so the sentence will read: "To accomplish this remedy, the Court will require Plaintiff Patricia E. King to cease using the name King's Funeral Home in the State of South Carolina."
2. The paragraph numbering on page seven (7) which includes a second paragraph four (4) is a scrivener's error and therefore paragraph number four (4) on page seven (7) is changed to paragraph six (6).
3. Paragraph a of the Ordering provisions on page eight (8) of the Final Order is amended by adding the words "in the State of South Carolina no later than sixty (60)

days from the filing of this order.” so the sentence will read: “a. The Defendant’s counterclaim for unjust enrichment is granted and the Plaintiff Patricia E. King is hereby ordered to cease using the name King’s Funeral Home in the state of South Carolina no later than sixty (60) days from the filing of this order.”

4. The remaining provisions of the Final Order shall remain unchanged.
