## ORDER

Appellant filed the notice of appeal from an "Order denying motion to vacate writ of assistance and order of dismissal" on April 14, 2014. Appellant has since then repeatedly failed to comply with South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Most recently, this court granted Appellant an extension of time to serve and file the record on appeal by August 24, 2015, warning that "[f]ailure to do so may result in the dismissal of this appeal." Appellant failed to serve and file the record on appeal by August 24, 2015. Although Appellant has now filed five copies of the record on appeal and served one, Appellant's record is deficient.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, as of the date of this order, Appellant has still failed to serve and file a record on appeal that is in compliance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. It is for this reason that Respondent's motion to dismiss is granted. The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
