Dear Mr. Pachak,

I am writing in concern of the above referenced matter.

In which, I have a few issues that I am forced to expound upon concerning your appointment and representation of me on direct appeal.

To begin with, words can not express my disappointment of your submitting an "Anders brief" on behalf of my appeal. Because I can not afford to retain counsel should not be the cause for your unwillingness to represent me. And, I surely don't believe my cause is unpopular, repugnant, or unreasonably burdensome and/or imposes a financial sacrifice upon you when the "ABA" house of delegates has formally acknowledged "the basic responsibility of lawyers engaged in the practice of law is to provide public interest services" without

a fee due to coping with the web of Statutes, Rules, and regulations for persons of limited means.

Moreover, the basic responsibility for providing legal services for those unable to pay ultimately rests upon you, and this State has instituted additional programs for that purpose. Plus, you assisting me now may prove to be a rewarding experience and a possible fast friendship between us as we both are zealous in advancing the law.

Secondly, you indicated in your letter dated May 28, 2015, that all issues raised in this case is yours. As much as I disagree with that notion, you never consulted me about what issues I felt should be included in your brief prior to forwarding me your Anders brief, record on appeal, and transcripts from both trials. Your reasons for not filing both trial transcripts escapes my sense of fairness or reasonableness in that either you did not thoroughly examine the transcripts, or you simply felt that my liberty was meaningless due to my limited means and/or inability to pay for your services.


Nevertheless, I am now experiencing difficulties with the States' attorney

Who insists that portions of my designation of matter should be stricken because you did not include both transcripts on your designation of matter and record on appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to rule 407 S.C.A.R. I'm instructing you to supplement the record on appeal to include the February 11<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014, transcript in your designation of matter within (10) ten calendar day from the receipt of this letter. Failure to comply with this instruction will render your assistance ineffective pursuant to Anders v. California, Evetts v. Lucy, and Strickland v. Washington, as well as my 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment guarantee of effective assistance of appellate counsel.

Finally, as I pursue relief, my attempt is not to subvert the judicial process, but rather, embrace it with vigor so that the interest of justice prevails.


