I did share a couple things with Judge verdin. I don't know any thing about what Judge verdin had said But I did tell her in my affidavit. I believed something Hokey was going on.

I told Ms. Desiree Allen about this and she responded that Hollie Jenkins was a trustworthy Helper and She may be but in this case it was questionable. Because I thought Mrs Allen was an officer of the court I felt I could trust her. I also discussed these happenings with Michelle Owens, one of Ms. Allen's mates..

If Holly Jenkins has the actual tape available I would ask you to compel her to produce it.


I was told by Ms. Moica Cassidy it may be too late. So I have followed what she says the best I can since it is hard to navigate as a pro se appellant.

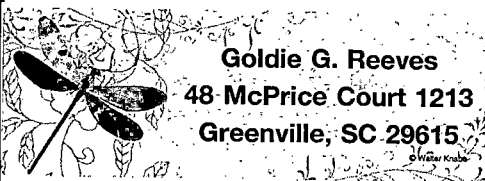

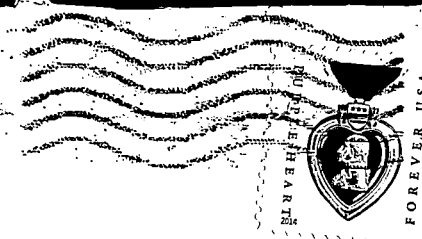
