**MOTION FOR AN ADDITIONAL FOUR DAY EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
APPELLANTS' INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

Appellants, Norman K. Tiffany, Individually, Brown Trucking Company; and Brown Integrated Logistics, by and through its undersigned counsel, and with the consent of all parties, respectfully request a four (4) day extension of time to file the Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter, which are currently due November 16, 2015. A four day extension would result in a new due date of November 20, 2015.
