This responds to your motion dated November 6, 2015.

Your counsel has not submitted a brief and petition to be relieved as counsel under *Anders v. California*. Therefore, you do not have any right to submit a *pro se* brief under *Anders v. California* at this time. *See State v. Williams*, 305 S.C. 116, 406 S.E.2 367 (1991) (discussing processing of *Anders* cases under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules).

Further, since counsel has already been appointed for you in this matter, the only *pro se* motion that you can currently make in this appeal under this Court's order of January 30, 2014, is a motion to relieve Lara Mary Caudy, Esquire, as your counsel in this appeal, and then only for good cause.
