Upon arrival at South Carolina Department of corrections I found out that I will be doing 3 years day for day in the YOA program without time served. My Attorney advised me that this was the best deal possible (ineffective Assistance of counsel). The YOA program did not seem like a bad idea until I actually got here. It's a lot of self help and I've accomplished many things on my own and not because of the program or the people who I'm supervised by that represent the program. I've

gotten a Silver on my work keys,
Most improved Certificates in Healthy
Relationships and Employability Skills Curriculum.
Im also currently enrolled in GED and
Welding and I won 3rd place in a Self
Control Writing contest. By doing so it
help me have motivation to do what is
right for myself and rebuild my self esteem
and Enthusiam. Both of my Co Defendants
Jase Summers and Devan Perry were also
Sentenced to YOA but with less time
and are eligible for parole in 2016.
I am writting this letter because I
would like to appeal my sentence and
for my case to be heard.
