ORDER

Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief was denied by Judge Goldsmith. No notice of appeal was filed. Petitioner now seeks a writ of certiorari from an order issued by Judge Young granting petitioner a belated review of Judge Goldsmith's order pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991).

We grant the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Young's order, dispense with further briefing, and proceed with an *Austin* review of Judge Goldsmith's order.

Petitioner's counsel asserts that the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Goldsmith's order is without merit and requests permission to withdraw from further representation. Petitioner has filed a *pro se* petition.

After careful consideration of the record as required by *Johnson v. State*, 294 S.C. 310, 364 S.E.2d 201 (1988), we deny the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Goldsmith's order and grant counsel's request to withdraw.
