




ORDER


Petitioners move for an extension of time to serve and file a petition for a writ of certiorari pursuant to Rule 242, SCACR, or in the alternative, for the time limits for serving and filing a petition to be held in abeyance pending a decision by the Court of Appeals on petitioners' second petition for rehearing and suggestion for rehearing en banc. Respondent has filed a return in opposition to the motion, to which petitioners have filed a reply. We deny petitioners' request to hold the time limits for filing a petition for a writ of certiorari in abeyance, as we find petitioners' second petition for rehearing improper. However, we grant petitioners a twenty day extension of time, which shall run from the date of this order, to serve and file a petition for a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and an accompanying appendix.


