NOTICE OF APPEAL

Appellant hereby respectfully appeals the PCR decision in the above captioned case pursuant to Rule 203 and 243 of the State Appellate Rules of Court. *USAA Property and Cas. Ins. Co. v Clegg*, 661 SE 2d 791 (SC 2008), *South bridge Properties, Inc v Jones*, 355 SE 2d 535 (SC 1987).

Appellant intended to file a Rule 59(e) Motion to Alter and/or Amend and Reconsider the dismissal by the PCR Judge through PCR attorney, Scott Robinson. Conflict exist and ongoing between Mr Robinson and Appellant. My attorney is uncooperative.

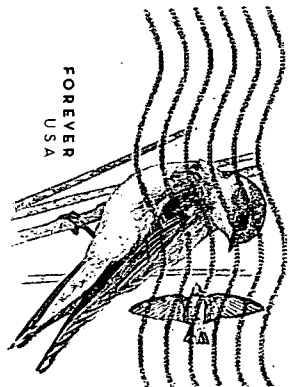

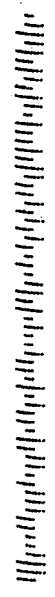
