MOTION FOR ENLARGING TIME
AFTER EXPIRATION OF ORIGINAL TIME

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that Bobby Ruff, the Appellant in the above-entitled action, moves the Court for permission extending the time in which Appellant is required to file Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. In addition, to waive any filing fee for the same.

The motion is made on the grounds that circumstances beyond his control hindered his efforts for filing his initial brief and designation of matter. 

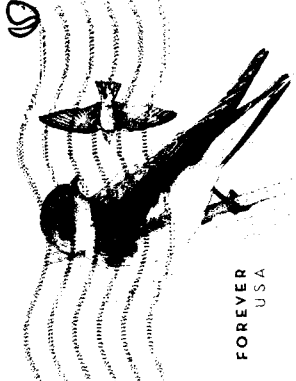
