Previously, Appellant/Respondent Univar USA Inc. ("Univar") filed a motion entitled "Consent Motion for Dismissal of Cross-Appeals and Remand to Circuit Court for Consummation of Settlement." This motion asked the Court to dismiss the cross-appeals taken by Univar and Respondents/Appellants Keith Black, Curtis Martin, and Tina Ann Martin (collectively "Black/Martin") and remanding this matter to the circuit court as to these parties so that court was vested with jurisdiction to take any action necessary to effectuate the settlement reached between these parties.¹ By order filed June 11, 2012, the Court granted the aforementioned motion, and instructed that it be promptly notified when the circuit court had taken action on the proposed settlement.

Please be advised that the settlement between Univar and Black/Martin has now been consummated, with Mr. Black and the Martins' respective suits against Univar being fully and finally dismissed, with prejudice, in the circuit court. If the Court has any questions or concerns or needs anything further in this regard, please let me know. Thank you for your kind attention to this matter.

¹ As between Univar and Appellants Scott F. Lawing and Tammy R. Lawing, the appeal has already been dismissed, with the settlement reached between these parties consummated.
