CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX


Counsel for Edward Martin Clarkson respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Edward Martin Clarkson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Noah Mumford with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Noah Mumford v. State with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of State v. William Donald Bolt with the Court of Appeals on October 22, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jason Allen Johnson before the Supreme Court on October 20, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Sheldon Lamar Kelly with the Supreme Court on October 14, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Chad Junior Bussell with the Court of Appeals on October 13, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Kevin T. Bennett before the Supreme Court on October 6, 2015. Due to weather conditions experienced in Columbia, State offices were closed on October 5, 6, 8, and 9, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kenneth D. Smith v. State with the Supreme Court on September 30, 2015.






