
WILLIAM TONY WATTS, II)

This matter was heard by the Honorable Tanya Amber Gee on October 27th, 2015. The State was represented by the Petitioner, Assistant Solicitor Suzanne Mayes of the Eleventh Circuit Solicitor's Office. William Tony Watts, II, was present and acted in a Pro Se capacity. Also present was Mr. Arthur E. White, Jr., Guardian Ad Litem for William Tony Watts, II.

Mr. William Tony Watts, II, appealed a Probate Court commitment which was ordered by Associate Probate Court Judge Julie Thompson on December 10th, 2014. The appeal by Mr. Watts is based upon his objection to testimony offered by several witnesses during the Probate Court proceedings, including the testimony of Dr. Samantha Horsley, Ph. D., of the S.C. Department of Mental Health; law enforcement Officer Roger Singleton; John Safko, Jr., M. Ed., and Tommy Smoak.

After hearing argument from Mr. Watts regarding the basis of his appeal, and also from the State (Petitioner) in response, Mr. Watts' appeal of the Probate Court Order of Judicial Admission is hereby denied.
