ORDER

After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to "reconsider Appellant's Amended Designation of Matter and Amended Brief" is denied. Appellant is reminded that on August 31, 2015, this court struck from Appellant's designation of matter the complaint, answer, defendant's request to charge no. 5, and defendant's exhibit A-J. Appellant was given ten days to serve and file an amended designation of matter that omitted these matters. Pursuant to Rule 221(c), SCACR, "[t]he appellate court will not entertain petition for rehearing on a motion . . . unless the action of the court on the motion . . . has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal." Accordingly, within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended designation of matter that complies with this court's August 31, 2015 order. Failure to do so may result in the dismissal of this appeal.¹
