MOTION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE RETURN TO PETITION FOR
REHEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Respondent, Willie Homer Stephens, Guardian ad Litem for Lillian C., a minor, respectfully requests a ten-day extension to file a Return to Petitioner, CSX Transportation, Inc. and South Carolina Department of Transportation's petition for rehearing. 
