

Pursuant to Rule 263(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Respondent Bank of America, N.A. successor by merger to BAC Home Loans Servicing, LP f/k/a Countrywide Home Loan Servicing, LP (BANA) respectfully requests that the Court issue an order that extends its deadline to file an initial brief and to designate matters for inclusion in the Record for Appeal by twenty-one days. Appellant's counsel consents to BANA's request for an extension. This case was transferred from BANA's trial counsel to the undersigned appellate counsel on October 28, 2015, which was two days after Appellant filed her initial brief on October 26, 2015. 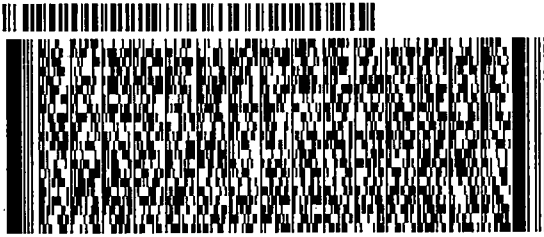

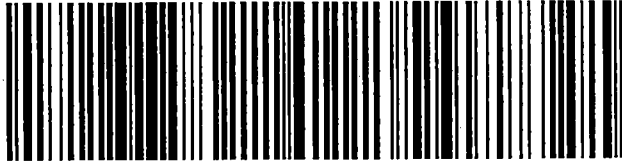
