ORDER

This case was partially dismissed and remitted to the Clerk of Court for Richland County on July 31, 2015. Respondent has filed a motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, seeking payment for attorney's fees and expenses related to the partial dismissal. This motion is denied.

Appellants have filed a motion requesting a second extension of the time to file their initial brief and designation of matter. Respondent opposed the motion in a return, and Appellants filed a reply to the return along with a motion to file the reply out of time. Appellants' motions are granted, and Appellants shall serve and file their initial brief and designation of matter within twenty days of entry of this order. No further extensions will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances, and failure to serve and file these documents within this timeframe may result in the dismissal of this appeal.

On October 7, 2015, this court received a letter from Respondent which we construe as a motion to dismiss the appeal due to Appellants' failure to timely serve and file their initial brief and designation of matter. This motion is denied.

On October 12, 2015, this court received a letter from Appellants requesting that we remove several documents from the appellate case file. Specifically, Appellants ask for the removal of (1) exhibits filed in support of Respondent's return to Appellants' motion for an extension, and (2) Respondent's return to a motion for sanctions that Appellant never filed with this court. Respondent consents to withdrawing the return to the unfiled motion for sanctions. Appellant's request is granted with respect to the return but denied as to the exhibits.
