Upon reviewing your designation of matter, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the cover of the designation must read "Designation of Matter", and the appellant's mailing information must be located in the lower right hand corner of the cover of the designation.
- The designation must clearly identify what the party desires to have included in the Record on Appeal, and the designation may only propose to include portions of the transcript, pleadings, orders, exhibits, or other materials which may be properly included in the Record on Appeal [See Rule 210(c), also see Appendix C Forms for examples].
