I Robin L. Evans file before this honorable court an appeal for the guilty plea to first Degree Harassment. The original charge was for felony Stalking. I have several important issues which shows the need for an appeal

(1) I was not extradited to Statesville North Carolina where the offense took place, the moment this fear and emotional distress of bodily injury or death occurred, the violation of stalking occurred. The location of this violation was in Statesville, N.C. SC had no jurisdiction in this matter.

(2) Crossing state lines involving stalking is interstate stalking, that is federal jurisdiction.

(4) The in the issue of jurisdiction. Who actually had jurisdiction? The answer is the US District Attorney, Marion SC Sheriff Department and Marion County Solicitor's office basically trumped up a stalking charge on me. They created a condition to where I need two different attorneys in two different states.

(5) SC created a difficult situation

④ in which it makes it difficult for the defendant Robin Evans to be able to put interstate subpoenas on the employees ~~and~~ of Elmco Products in Statesville, NC. The defendant Robin Evans should have been extended to where the offense of stalking took place to be able to confront his accusers and have witnesses on his side.
