Appellant filed a notice of appeal from a circuit court order denying Appellant's motion to enjoin or stay proceedings. Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal. After a thorough review of the parties' filings, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 14-3-330(4) (Supp. 2014) (providing that "[a]n interlocutory order or decree in a court of common pleas . . . refusing an injunction" is immediately appealable); *Williams v. Nw. Sec. Life Ins. Co.*, 307 S.C. 462, 463-64, 415 S.E.2d 809, 809-10 (1992) (holding a circuit court's order denying a defendant's motion to dismiss a plaintiff's claims based upon a previously issued injunction was "within the parameters of" section 14-3-330(4)).
