
Dear Mr. Lowery:

Upon reviewing your letter regarding ordering the transcript, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The document does not show that a copy of this correspondence was provided to the opposing party/counsel unless your only respondent is PHH Mortgage Corp., and if Mary P. Jones is the attorney for that respondent. Your latest caption shows four respondents.
- A copy of this document was not provided to the Office of Court Administration as required by the SCACR. The address for Court Administration is 1220 Senate Street, Suite 200, Columbia, SC 29201. All documents regarding transcripts must be copied on the Office of Court Administration.
- Our records reflect that the time for ordering the transcript has expired. Within ten days of the date of this letter, you must file a copy of a letter

showing that you have ordered the transcript directly from the court reporter, along with a motion requesting permission to order the transcript outside of the filing deadlines set by Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Your appeal will be dismissed if no motion is made within ten days of the date of this letter.
