ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to timely serve the notice of appeal. Appellant has now filed a motion to reinstate, demonstrating he served the notice of appeal within thirty days of the entry of the underlying order. Accordingly, this appeal is reinstated.

However, a preliminary review of the underlying order indicates it may not be appealable. Appellant is therefore directed to serve and file a memorandum addressing the issue of appealability within ten days. The time limits for perfecting the appeal are held in abeyance pending the Court's consideration of the memorandum.
