This office has received your letter requesting protection from court appearances and filings, dated November 27, 2015. Please be advised that the Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court, unlike the trial courts, do not grant orders of protection.

Instead, if you have a case pending before the Court of Appeals and some action is required in your absence, you will need to seek an extension in that individual case by filing a motion under Rule 240, SCACR. Should the court decide to set this case for oral argument, you will be notified by letter of the possible dates for argument. At that time, you can send the Court a response to let us know the date on which you have a problem.

Please also be aware that when filing documents with the Court, if you have multiple appeals currently active with the Court, you must file separately for each case.
