4. The undersigned consulted with opposing counsel and is authorized to advise the Court counsel does not oppose the requested relief.





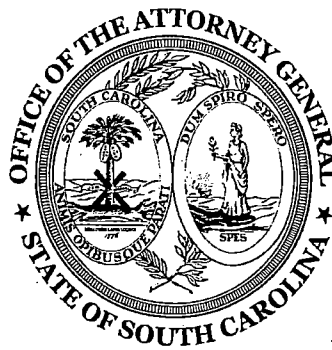
