ORDER

By order dated October 15, 2015, the petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in this matter was dismissed.¹ This order found that the Court of Appeals had properly sent the remittitur after petitioner failed to timely seek rehearing or reinstatement following the dismissal of the appeal.

Petitioner has now filed a second petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of the decision of the Court of Appeals. This petition is dated November 4, 2015, and was received by this Court on December 7, 2015.

Appellate jurisdiction over this case ended when the remittitur was sent on July 15, 2015, and no further motions or petitions can be considered by either appellate court after that date. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Accordingly, the second petition for a writ of certiorari is hereby stricken and dismissed.
