On behalf of the Respondent South Carolina Public Charter School District (“District”), I am writing in response to this Court's Order dated November 11, 2015 and to renew the District's request to deny Appellant's Motion to Reinstate. On November 11, 2015, this Court entered an Order requiring Appellant to correct certain deficiencies in its briefs and the record on appeal prior to the Court considering Appellant's Motion to Reinstate. Appellants filed the Motion to Reinstate following this Court's second dismissal of the appeal for Appellant's failure to follow this Court's rules and comply with this Court's instructions.


On or about November 30, Appellants submitted revised final briefs. However, Appellant's briefs still contain numerous deficiencies. Most importantly, neither brief cites to the Record on Appeal as required by Rule 211, SCACR. In addition, Appellants' final briefs also lack proofs of service, are missing pages, and lack the required certificates of counsel. Furthermore, the District has not been served with the revised or supplemental Record on Appeal in which the confidential identifying information of Appellant's students has been redacted.
